
## Ciclosporin

A drug that suppresses the immune system



#### Patients must have regular blood tests

Note that benefits of treatment are usually greater than the risks; consult your doctor

### Ciclosporin

A drug that suppresses the immune system



#### Common Interactions with other medicines

+ Statins (cholesterol-lowering drugs)= increased risk of muscle breakdown and muscle pain.

+ Grapefruit juice = raises the levels of ciclosporin in the blood.
+ Digoxin = Levels of digoxin increase, so increased risk of digoxin toxicity.
+ Pain killers like Ibuprofen and diclofenac (Non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs)= increased risk of toxicity to kidneys.

+ Antibacterials like erythromycin and Antifungals like itraconazole= ciclosporin levels go up.
+ Some types of diuretics ('water tablets'): potassium-sparing diuretics and aldosterone antagonists = increases potassium levels in body.
